North County Teen Court (NCTC) was founded in 2006 by Sherman resident Mr. Robert Hoffek and Mr. Philip Brown, retired Police Officer. Police departments from Williamsville, Riverton, Spaulding, Rochester and Grandview currently work with the NCTC.

NCTC represents a positive alternative to the juvenile justice system and holds juvenile offenders accountable for a sentence imposed by a jury of their peers. By offering this alternative system, we allow youth who have made poor decisions an opportunity to recognize their mistakes and learn valuable lessons. At the same time, participating youth increase respect for themselves, schools, law enforcement, the community and the legal system.

Teen Court hearings are typically held the second Monday and Wednesday of the month in Williamsville and Riverton. Fifteen to sixteen teen court jurors and volunteers hear cases from the various communities.

As a not-for-profit and a 501(c)(3), NCTC relies on the generosity of the local communities, Village Boards, various organizations and individuals who believe in our mission and vision. These donations have allowed the NCTC to operate for the past twelve years. The annual average expense to operate NCTC is \$3,050. NCTC has no paid positions, everyone is a volunteer.

As a 501(c)(3), NCTC qualifies to receive tax deductible bequests, devices, transfers or gifts under Section 2055, 2106, or 2522.
