North County Teen Court (NCTC) was founded in 2006 by Sherman resident Mr. Robert Hoffek and Mr. Philip Brown, retired Police Officer. Police departments from Williamsville, Riverton, Spaulding, Rochester and Grandview currently work with the NCTC.


NCTC represents a positive alternative to the juvenile justice system and holds juvenile offenders accountable for a sentence imposed by a jury of their peers. By offering this alternative system, we allow youth who have made poor decisions an opportunity to recognize their mistakes and learn valuable lessons. At the same time, participating youth increase respect for themselves, schools, law enforcement, the community and the legal system.

Teen Court hearings are typically held the second Monday and Wednesday of the month in Williamsville and Riverton. Fifteen to sixteen teen court jurors and volunteers hear cases from the various communities. Prior to the court hearings, we provide a simple meal for our teen court jurors and volunteers since many of them do not have time to eat prior to the hearings. The cost of providing these meals is the third highest annual expense for NCTC.

We are seeking businesses or individuals to partner with NCTC to provide a meal for our Williamsville and Riverton teen court jurors and volunteers once a year. NCTC is a 501(c)(3); therefore, your donation is tax deductible. Adult volunteers who serve as parent coordinators for our Teen Courts will work with the partnering donors to schedule pick up or delivery times for the meal donations prior to the hearings.
